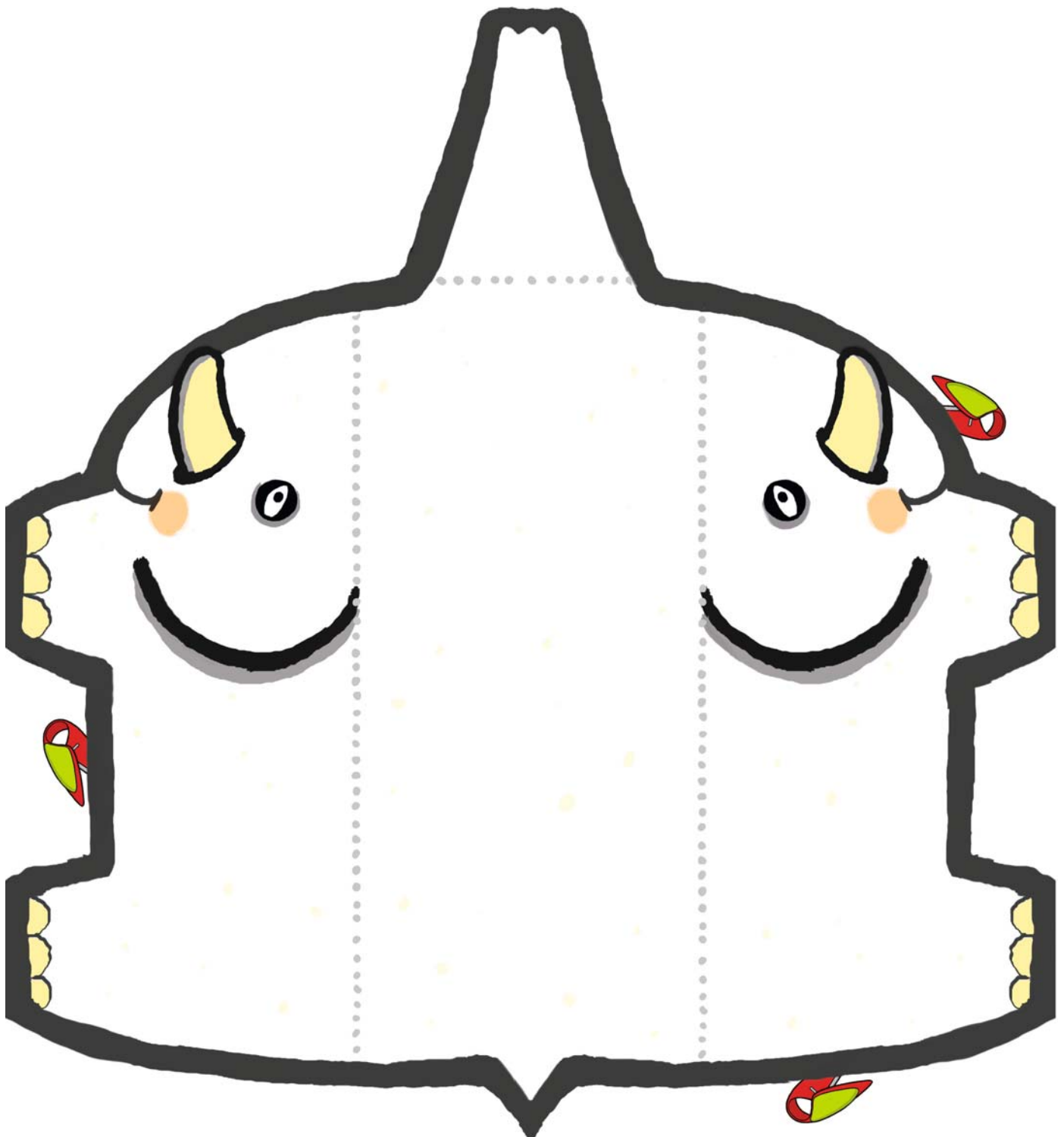


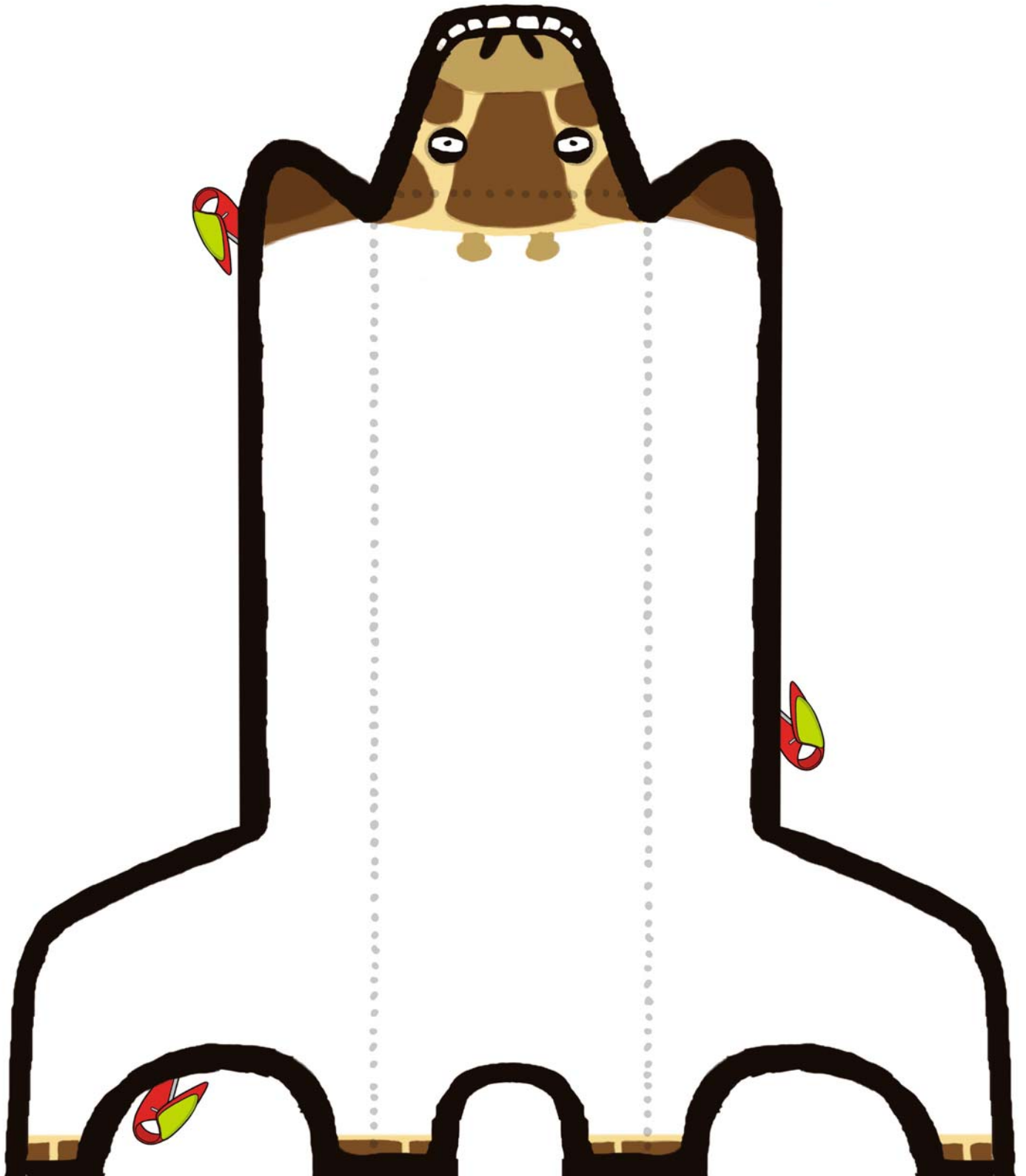
SNIP! SNAP! SNIP! ZOO

SNIP! SNAP! SNIP! ZOO

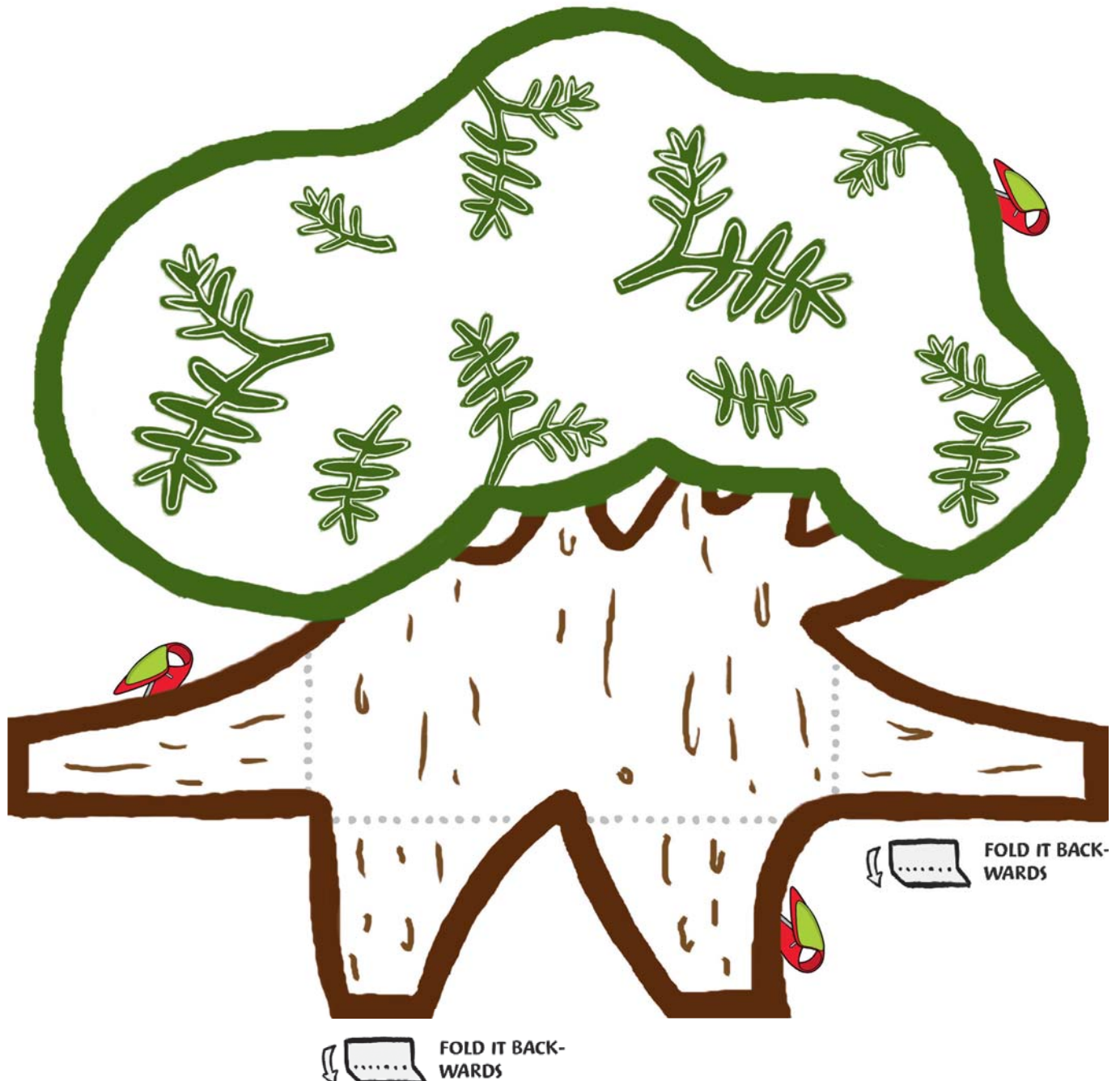

Do you know what a giraffe looks like? Take a book about animals, look it up and draw a nice giraffe skin pattern. Then simply fold the giraffe along the dotted lines.

There are lots of plants in your zoo which provide shade and protection for the animals, which also use them for climbing and as food. Giraffes absolutely love eating leaves from the acacia tree which is their favourite tree.

Snip! Snap! Snip! – the FABER-CASTELL children’s scissors go and cut out the figure of a tree. Then colour the tree and fold it along the dotted lines.

The spider would love to make itself comfortable in a cosy corner of your zoo. Snip! Snap! Snip! – the FABER-CASTELL children's scissors go and cut out its figure. As there are so many legs to cut out, it is best to start cutting at the outside and move towards the inside by following the arrows. Now colour the spider in your favourite hues and fold the figure along the dotted lines.
